1. KRC

Conference Theme: Traditional Wisdom and Modern Knowledge for the Earth's Future

Date: August 5- August 9

Sessions of C12.29 will be held on August 5 and August 6

*: Tentative programme of the Sessions of all the Commissions was sent by email to the Japanese liaisons by the Chair of the Programme Committee of KRC on 8 May. It shows all of three Sessions of C12.29 is to be held from the afternoon of August 5 to the evening of August 6. The programme will be decided formally after 10 May when the Commission does not tell him other hope and opinion during from 8 to 10 May. The tentative programme is attached.

Venue: Kyoto International Conference Center

It is located in the north of Kyoto City. You will arrive there within 30 minutes by subway from the Kyoto Station.

2. Excursion of C12.29

Date: August 9 – August 11 (Chartered bus)

Itineraries and visiting spots:

August 9: 8 o'clock start from the APA Hotel

10:45: Japanese Paper Museum at Mino City of Gifu Pref. (paper making, lunch, visit to a traditional paper maker named *Mamoru Sawamura* at Goju-mura settlement)

14:45: Meihou area of Gujo City (Exchange with the NPO and action groups for local development with the explanation by *Yu-ichi Okida*, Head of the Meihou Promotion Office/former municipal office)

17:30: The Yoshida-ya Hotel (Dinner and stay. It is located at the central area of Gujo-Hachiman Castle town with famous cultural landscape. The Bon-dance is performed in the Ima-machi Community during ca. 19:00-21:00.)

August 10: 7:30 breakfast, 8:45 visit to the Castle

10:15 start from the Yoshida-ya Hotel

11:30 Visit to Shirakawa-gou mountain village (Wooden houses with a steep five-layer rafter roof, lunch)

14:00 Miboro dam and reservoir (

15:30 Visit to Local Culture Museum of Taira village of Gokayama Region

16:30 Ainokura Settlement (Dinner and stay at the Nakaya guest house. World Cultural Heritage, Wooden houses with a steep three-layer rafter roof, The juridical-person body of the inhabitants of Ainokura manages the settlement and the landscape. More than half homes manage guest houses. We stay at a guest house exclusively. Its head is the chief of the juridical-person body. After dinner we will have the opportunity to listen from him the local history and the way to manage the Ainokura-world heritage settlement.)

August 11: 7:00 breakfast, 8:30 start

9:30 Woodworking Museum and exhibition and the walking of Inami monzenmachi, that is, the town which grew up around the gate of a major Shinshu Sect temple

12:00 Lunch

13:00 Tonami Region famous for dispersed settlements (Museum, View from Yumenodaira, Visit to the House of *Masao Shindo*, the Head of the Museum, His house is the typical homestead. He will guide us the structure and function of a farmstead of the Tonami dispersed settlement)

16:30 Breakup at the Toyama Station (to Tokyo)

(17:30-18:00 at the Kanazawa Station (to Kyoto, Osaka))

(If you wish to go to the Toyama Airport or the Komatsu Airport, please inform me of it beforehand.)

On August 9: Prof Koh-ichi Togashi of Gifu University will support us and elucidate the contents and characteristics the local development activities in Gifu prefecture.

*As the Yoshida-ya Hotel is composed of three single rooms and six twin rooms (both are with the bathroom ensuite) in total except the gardens and large bath, more than half the participants will stay at the twin room by two.

If you have a hope to stay one more day on August 12 in Noto/Hokuriku Region, please inform me of it.

As the Commission Sessions are to be held on August 5 and 6, I will try to think one or two optional short trip or experience visit for the for vacant time. Actual expenses may be collected from the participants.

One-day subway ticket would be better for us. You can freely ride and drop the subway/tube in a day if we buy one-day ticket.
