If you do not inform us of this information, your party may be refused entry to the Kyoto Imperial Palace.
- 1. Kyoto Imperial Palace is closed on Saturdays, Sundays, National Holidays, and the year-end. During these dates, the tour will visit Kitano-tenmangu Shrine instead. The same is true of the period before and after the public viewing of the Kyoto Imperial Palace in April and October, May 14 to May 17 due to the Aoi Festival, as well as when there is an Imperial Household event.
- 2. Nishi Hongwanji Temple will be visited on May 25 and August 25 instead of Kitano-tenmangu Shrine.
- 3. Nijo Castle is closed on every Tuesday in January, July, August, and December. During these dates, the tour will visit Ryoanji Temple instead.
- 4. Before entering Kyoto Imperial Palace, it is required to complete a form indicating full name, nationality, gender, and age.
- 5. Chishaku Temple will be visited when Heian Jingu Shrine is closed to Jidai Festival on October 22nd. If the festival is postponed, changes in the itinerary may also be postponed.
- 6. Drop off service to Karasuma Kyoto Hotel, Hotel Nikko Princes Kyoto, and Hotel Monterey Kyoto cannot be provided during Gion Festival (July 14th-16th) due to traffic restrictions.
- 7. Pick-up service from Kyoto Hotel Okura and Karasuma Kyoto Hotel cannot be provided during Gion Festival (7/17) and Jidai Festival (10/22) due to traffic restrictions.
- 8. Connections to Kyoto Maiko Dinner will be made from either Kyoto Hotel Okura or Kiyomizudera Temple bus parking lot.
- 9. Connection to Kyoto Night Tour is not possible due to time constraints.
