

SECURITY ANNOUNCEMENT

Prohibited Items at Kyoto International Conference Center

Visitors are strictly prohibited from bringing any of the following items onto the premises. Please note that prohibited items found by the security staff will be temporarily kept or discarded.

1. Firearms of any kind
2. Sharp-edged tools such as swords, knives and cutters, ice picks, needles, nails, and especially sharp scissors
3. Poisonous substances, chemical substances, and other toxic substances
4. Flares, firecrackers, fireworks, explosives, gun powder, illuminating shells, oils, inflammable materials, and other hazardous materials
5. Stones, bins, cans, crockery and such items that could harm someone by being thrown within the premises
6. Laser pointers, whistles, air sprays and such items that could disturb the opening ceremony
7. Poles, hammers, screwdrivers, chains and such items that could be used as weapons
8. Umbrellas with sharp points, except collapsible ones considered safe by the security staff
9. Bulletin boards, signs, banners, placards, documents, pictures, prints and such items that could disrupt the opening ceremony
10. Helmets, masks, saddlecloths and such items that could disrupt the opening ceremony
11. Confetti, paper tapes and rolls of toilet paper
12. Whistles, megaphones, instruments, music players, security buzzers and such items that could emit a loud sound
13. Alcohol
14. Ice boxes and large or numerous pieces of luggage
15. Animals except guide dogs and hearing dogs
16. Wireless communications devices except mobile phones and PHS devices
17. Other items that could impede the progress of the opening ceremony and cause trouble or danger to others, as well as whatever the security staff deems to pose such a risk
